The Illustrated Burra Charter has been written by Meredith Walker and Peter Marquis-Kyle and is approved by the Australia ICOMOS Executive.

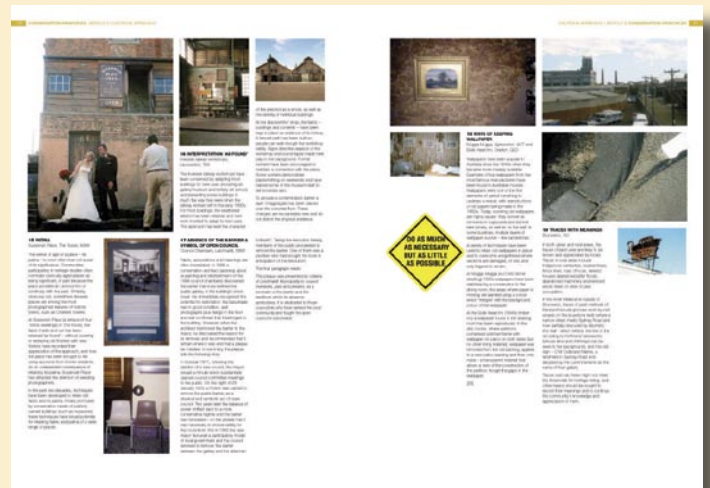
About the Illustrated Burra Charter

The Burra Charter (the Australia ICOMOS Charter for Places of Cultural Significance) has now gone through a third revision. The last revision was substantial, leading to major changes reflecting the evolution of cultural heritage conservation practice since the Charter was first adopted in 1979. This third revision was adopted by the Annual General Meeting of Australia ICOMOS in November 1999 and has been subsequently endorsed by various government bodies as the definitive statement on best practice for Australians working in the field.

Because of the important changes embodied in the 1999 revision of the Charter, a new edition of the companion Australia ICOMOS document, the Illustrated Burra Charter: Good Practice for Heritage Places has been prepared. The text picks up the new ideas in the revised Charter, especially the broadening of the concept of cultural significance to include not only fabric but also use, associations and meanings.
