Currently, NC ICOMOS, Russia has 371 people in 13 branches throughout the country, which makes it one of the largest organizations in the ICOMOS family. However, in 2014 the Russian organization was deprived of accreditation. There were reasons for that. I have been a member of ICOMOS since the mid-1990s, since the mid-2000s I have noticed that our organization has stopped to engage in practical work. I'm proud to have joined a group of volunteers who set out to revive the accreditation of ICOMOS, Russia. In 2016, we achieved that goal. In four years the number of members of ICOMOS, Russia has increased by 123 people, numerous conferences and scientific symposiums have been held. The bodies of state power began to apply to NC ICOMOS, Russia for consultations. The objects of Pskov's church architecture were included in the list of World Heritage sites. The preliminary list of World Heritage includes such objects as the Historical and Cultural complex "Divnogorye", Onega and White Sea petroglyphs, petroglyphs of the Shulgan-Tash cave, Kazan observatories, etc. The Government of Russia has submitted for consideration a draft law on the implementation of the norms of the UNESCO Convention 1972 in the national legislation on the preservation of cultural heritage.

I was elected President of NC ICOMOS Russia in 2019 by my colleagues. Now my colleagues and I feel the need for closer integration into the ICOMOS community.

I see my mission, on the one hand, to offer my colleagues in ICOMOS a rich and diverse experience of Russia in preserving cultural heritage. On the other hand, participation in the work of the Council will allow for more active cooperation of the Russian organization with the international community. I hope that our cooperation will allow us to apply international experience more actively in the territory of the Russian Federation.
